- 1. ADA Improvements at Citrus Ave./Foothill Blvd. and Palm Dr./Foothill Blvd.**  
*The contracting of city-wide concrete improvements were not budgeted this fiscal year. The Street Department however is making repairs at locations that are deemed safety hazards, if necessary temporary asphalt ramping is provided.*
- 2. ADA Improvements at San Gabriel Blvd./9<sup>th</sup> St. and Azusa Ave./9<sup>th</sup> St. – Azusa Ave./ 9<sup>th</sup> Street will receive a signalized intersection as a result of the Right-of-Way Improvements for the development of the Target site. Intersections will receive full ADA ramps and pedestrian push buttons.**
- 3. ADA Access at Zacatecas Park, Pioneer Park and Northside Park. - Commission was briefed on the status of the ADA retrofits. Zacatecas Park is using a temporary ADA bathroom for the given time. ADA Retrofits to Pioneer Park and Northside Park are included in the Capital Improvement Plan as unfunded projects. Staff is seeking funding opportunities at this time.**
