AGENDA ITEMS

- 1. Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) – ADA Eligible Projects for FY 2011** *(Staff mentioned that CDBG programming for the FY 2011/12 is currently taking place. ADA improvements on public facilities and right of way are generally eligible projects. The ABC Commission was asked to provide recommendations for ADA projects. Commissioner Prowse indicated the Calera/Foothill intersection as a viable project. Staff to look into the projects merit and eligibility).*
- 2. Warrant Study for Bike Lanes on Foothill Boulevard (Between Alostia & Citrus)** *The Commission was informed city wide traffic warrant studies will be performed. Currently there is not enough space on the roadway to accommodate 4 roadway lanes and a class 2 bike lane. The warrant study may recommend the closure of one lane, therefore affording space for the installation of the class 2 bike lane. Commissioner Prowse, expressed during peak hours both lanes are heavily used and a lane closure will likely result in further traffic congestion.*
