CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) ADVISORY

Due to the state and local State of Emergency resulting from the threat of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), Governor Newsom has issued Executive Order N-29-20 in which Section 3 supersedes Paragraph 11 of Executive Order N-25-20 (issued on March 12, 2020) addressing Brown Act regulations. This new order states that the City does not need to make a physical location available for members of the public to observe a public meeting and offer public comment. The Order allows the City to hold City Council/Board meetings via teleconferencing and allows for members of the public to observe and address the meeting telephonically or electronically.

To follow the new Order issued by the Governor, the Art in Public Places Commission meeting scheduled for Wednesday, July 1, 2020 at 7:00 p.m at the Azusa Light and Water Building Conference Room located at 729 N. Azusa Avenue. Open to the Public Comment Only. Members of the public may submit **Public Comments by 6:30 p.m. electronically by emailing PublicComment@azusaca.gov or in person.** Emailed public comments will be sent to all City Commissioners Members and will be part of the record. (Comments shall be limited to no more than 250 words). Recording of the meeting will be posted to the City's website at a later day.
