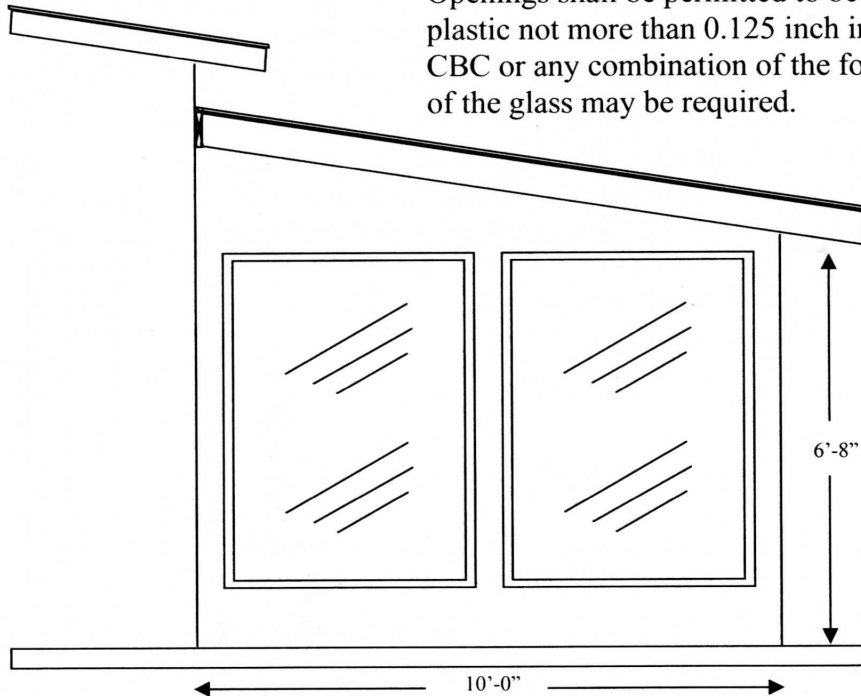




Patio Enclosure Requirements

Patio covers shall be permitted to be detached from or attached to dwelling units. Patio covers shall be used only for recreational, outdoor living purposes and not as carports, garages, storage rooms or habitable rooms.

Openings shall be permitted to be enclosed with insect screening, approved translucent or transparent plastic not more than 0.125 inch in thickness, glass conforming to the provisions of Chapter 24 of the CBC or any combination of the foregoing. Tempered glass or an approved film applied to both sides of the glass may be required.



Attached patio structures may not be enclosed if required openings from the dwelling unit used as emergency egress or rescue openings for sleeping rooms are within the enclosed structure.

The open area shall be on the *longer* wall and *one additional* wall. The open area of each wall is equal to at least 65% of the area below 6 feet 8 inches, measured from the floor, by the length of the wall.

Example: 10'-0" by 6'-8" is $10.0 \times 6.66 = 66.66$ sq ft.
 $66.66 \times .65\% = 43.33$ sq ft of actual open area.
